RESOLUTION: Maintain Buoy 100 During Winter Months Pending Future County Board Action on the Status of the Marker

WHEREAS, Buoy 100, near the north end of Lake Winnebago is part of the Navigation Aids Program; and

WHEREAS, requests have been made to the Parks Department to maintain Buoy 100 during the winter months; and;

WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Parks Committee deems that it would be appropriate to recommend to the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that the County Parks Department shall make a reasonable effort to maintain Buoy 100 for the remainder of this winter pending future County Board action on the status of the marker.
