1. <u>Kim Walsch – 6789 Woodenshoe Rd, Neenah – Conditional Use (Adjourned from the February public hearing).</u>

Applicant is requesting a conditional use permit for conducting wedding ceremonies in an existing barn. Kim Walsch – 6789 Wooden, Oshkosh was sworn in. Ms. Walsch stated that the Town Planning Commission of Neenah approved the conditional use request by a vote of 7-0 and the Town Board of Neenah approved the conditional use request by a vote of 7-0.
