- 1. Call to Order: P. O'Brien called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. <u>Approve Agenda:</u> Motion to approve the December 19, 2018 agenda, made by K. Robl and seconded by G. Konrad. Motion carried 9-0.
- 3. Public Comments on Agenda Items: None.
- 4. <u>Announcements/Communications:</u> J. Rabe proposed to the Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB) that the January 2, 2018 meeting be canceled due to the holidays. Meeting canceled.
  - J. Rabe informed the SWMB that Chris Anderson from Foth Infrastructure & Environment (Foth) dropped off prints of photos from the Ken Robl Conservation Park grand opening for the board members and select County Board supervisors.
- 5. <u>Approval of Minutes December 5, 2018 Open Session:</u> Motion to approve the December 5, 2018 open session minutes, made by J. Finch and seconded by S. Locke. Motion carried 9-0.

- 6. <u>Discussion/Action County Requirements to Satisfy Supervised Release Statutory Obligation:</u> M. Mueller presented the County Requirements to Satisfy Supervised Release Statutory Obligation to the SWMB as follows:
  - Act 184 was signed into law by Governor Scott Walker and became effective March 30, 2018; this act requires that the county that the sexually violent person (SVP) resided in must provide housing for the SVP upon their release
  - If the county does not find housing for a SVP being released, they can face up to \$1,100 in fines per day
  - The statute directed counties to form a supervised release committee; it is composed of Corporation Counel representatives Marry Anne Mueller, Jeff Mann and Tracy Rosenthal, Human Services representative Bill Topel, State Health Services representative Angie Serwas, State Corrections representative Ryan Braun, Geographic Information Systems representative Dean Kaderabek and Facilities representative Mike Elder
  - On May 23, 2018 Judge Thomas Gritton determined it was Winnebago County's responsibility to find housing for the SVP being released
  - The committee reviewed housing options through landlords that met the requirements for housing and were unable to find suitable housing; the committee began looking for county property to develop housing
  - The property between Winnebago County (WC) Highway Department and Solid Waste Department was one of the few properties that met all housing requirements; rezoning for institutional/residential and conditional use permit was approved by City of Oshkosh
  - On December 18, 2018 the Winnebago County Board approved the request for \$100,000 to build the housing unit on the WC Highway and Solid Waste Department property to house the SVP that is being released

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB.

Motion to endorse the memorandum that was sent to the WC Board of Supervisors on December 14, 2018, made by M. Easker and seconded by G. Konrad. Motion carried 8-0.

- 7. <u>Discussion/Action Authorize 2019 Landfill Gas Pipeline Compliance Services:</u> Z. Moureau presented the SWMB with the 2019 Landfill Gas Pipeline Compliance Services as follows:
  - Utility Safety & Design, Inc. (USDI) previously authorized for 2017 & 2018 landfill gas pipeline compliance services (\$2,300/month); USDI has done a good job to date with Public Service Commission (PSC) compliance.
  - \$30,000 included in 2019 Budget
  - USDI provided proposal \$28,152 for 2019 services (\$2,346 monthly)

Discussion ensued amongst the SWMB.

Motion made by D. Nelson and seconded by P. Eisen, to authorize a one (1) year agreement with USDI for \$28,152 for 2019 services. Motion carried 8-0.
