New Business: Tom Snider will email Mary Kolar, WDVA Secretary regarding the delay in the issuance of the certified certificate for the Property Tax Credit Program. This is prohibiting

veterans and surviving spouses from filing for their refunds. He is also still working with NACVSO on the legislation for federal funding of the CVSO Offices.
