

2 **RESOLUTION: Authorize the Winnebago County Sheriff’s Department to Accept Two**
3 **Separate Grants from the Homeland Security ALERT Program, Totaling**
4 **\$35,000, and Appropriate the Funds to Equipment and Small Equipment**
5 **Expense Accounts**

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8 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

9 **WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County Sheriff’s Department received grant funds from two separate Homeland
10 Security ALERT Grant Programs: Tactical Pole Camera (\$15,000) and SWAT Night Vision (\$20,000); and

11 **WHEREAS**, the total funds from these grants exceed estimated grant fund totals included in the Winnebago
12 County Sheriff’s Department’s 2019 Budget, as the amounts of these funds were unknown at the time the Budget
13 was prepared; and

14 **WHEREAS**, accepting the grant funding totaling \$35,000 and applying the funds to appropriate Equipment
15 and Small Equipment Expense Accounts would be beneficial to the efforts of the Sheriff’s Department to provide a
16 safer environment and, ultimately, to the residents of Winnebago County.

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18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
19 authorizes the Winnebago County Sheriff’s Department to accept grant funding from two separate Homeland
20 Security ALERT Grant Programs, totaling \$35,000, and appropriate the funds to Equipment and Small Equipment
21 Expense Accounts to be available to the Sheriff’s Department to meet program objectives in its efforts to provide a
22 safer environment for residents of Winnebago County.
