



Wisconsin's vaccine opt out rate has been increasing; it is 5X higher today than it was 20 years ago.



WI has some of the broadest exemption criterion. Over 90% of exemptions are for personal convictions (not medical or religious). Eliminating the personal conviction waiver can help increase herd immunity for our communities, keeping everyone safer from vaccine preventable disease.
