3 **ORDINANCE: Adopt Chapter 14 of the General Code of Winnebago County: Illicit Discharge**

10 **WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors finds that the uncontrolled discharge of pollutants
11 to its Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) has an adverse impact on the water quality of receiving waters;
12 and

13 **WHEREAS**, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has promulgated regulations
14 implementing the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the EPA has authorized the State of Wisconsin to issue NPDES permits under the Wisconsin
16 Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permit system; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the WPDES regulations require Winnebago County to control the contribution of pollutants to its
18 regulated MS4 by prohibiting illicit discharges, and to inspect, monitor, and enforce the prohibitions of illicit
19 discharges to its regulated MS4 via an Illicit Discharge and Illicit Connection Ordinance.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that Chapter 14 of
21 the General Code of Winnebago County is hereby adopted to read as follows:
