

2 **RESOLUTION: Authorize the Winnebago County Land and Water Conservation**
3 **Department to Accept a Natural Resource Damage Assessments Grant in**
4 **the Amount of \$21,000 for the 2020 Budget, and Appropriate the Funds to**
5 **Related Expenses**

8 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

9 **WHEREAS**, The Fox River/Green Bay Natural Resource Trustee Council has already awarded the Winnebago
10 County Land and Water Conservation Department \$200,000 of Natural Resource Damage Assessment (NRDA) funds
11 for the design, oversight, and construction of two off-shore break-wall projects on Lake Winneconne to protect emergent
12 and nearshore wetlands that provide fish spawning and rearing habitat and support migratory waterfowl stopover
13 habitat; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the cost of the projects have increased due to higher quarry material prices; and

15 **WHEREAS**, your Land and Water Conservation Department has requested and received additional NRDA
16 grant funds from the Fox River/Green Bay Natural Resource Trustee Council in the amount of \$21,000 to help cost-
17 share the increased project costs; and

18 **WHEREAS**, your Land Conservation Committee fully supports the projects and utilizing the NRDA funding.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
21 authorizes the Land and Water Conservation Department to accept a Natural Resource Damage Assessments grant
22 in the amount of \$21,000 for the 2020 Budget, and appropriate the funds to related expenses.
