15	WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Parks Department has identified numerous high-cost repairs and		
16	opportunities through the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan such as the Eureka concrete landing, Poygan		
17	concrete landing, Butte Des Morts parking and bathroom expansion in addition to parking lot maintenance and		
18	repaving at numerous locations coupled with dredging at numerous locations; and		
19	WHEREAS, the current Boat Landing fee is not sustainable if Winnebago County wants to pay for many of		
20	the above upgrades through the fees paid by boat landing users; and
