

2 **RESOLUTION: Add Section 0.0 (Role of the County Board Supervisor) to the**
3 **Rules of the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors**

5 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

6 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby adds Section 26 to the
7 Rules of the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors to read as follows:

8 **"0.0 ROLE OF THE COUNTY BOARD SUPERVISOR**

9 **0.1 Responsibilities of the County Board of Supervisors are defined by the laws of**
10 **the State of Wisconsin and the Rules of Order of the Winnebago County Board**
11 **of Supervisors.**

13 **0.2 County Supervisors are expected to individually contribute to a collaborative**
14 **effort to set a vision and strategic mission goals and make broad policy**
15 **decisions that support the strategic mission to advance the priorities of the**
16 **county. Examples of such activities, include, but are not limited to:**

- 17 **1. Participating in the process of debate and voting on proposed**
- 18 **ordinances, resolutions and motions in County Board and**
- 19 **Committee meetings;**
- 20 **2. Providing policy and direction to the management of the county**
- 21 **regarding delivery of county services while refraining from the**
- 22 **delivery, management or administration of daily operations of the**
- 23 **county;**
- 24 **3. Being responsive to the needs of their constituency through**
- 25 **effective communication;**
- 26 **4. Establishing priorities for the delivery of county services through**
- 27 **the annual budget and tax levy.**

28 **0.3 Service as a County Supervisor is an honor and a trust, which compels the**
29 **office holder to serve the public through use of his or her judgment for the**
30 **benefit of the public, and binds him or her to uphold the Constitution of the**
31 **United States, the Constitution of the State of Wisconsin, and to carry out**
32 **impartially the laws of the Nation, State and County.**
