3 **RESOLUTION:** Authorize the Sheriff's Office to accept a \$113,209.00 Local Law Enforcement Agency
4 Initiative Grant from the State of Wisconsin to be used for specialized training, equipment,
5 and recruitment incentives.

8 **TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

9 **WHEREAS**, In March of 2022 the Governor of Wisconsin announced grant funding totaling \$19 million allocated
10 to every local and tribal law enforcement agency across the state; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the mechanism for receiving the funding first became available on August 16, 2022; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the program is intended to provide law enforcement agencies with additional resources to help
13 offset specific costs; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the funds for this program have specific uses to reimburse the costs of providing specialized
15 training; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the funds for this program have specific uses equipping law enforcement officers, jail personnel
17 and dispatchers; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the program provides funding for recruitment incentives for hiring law enforcement officers, jail
19 personnel, and dispatchers; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office total allocation is \$113,209; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office will designate \$34,000 of the total allocation towards
22 recruitment incentives; and

23 **WHEREAS**, all grant funds must be used before June 30, 2023.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby
26 authorizes the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office to accept a \$113,209.00 Local Law Enforcement Agency Initiative
27 Grant from the State of Wisconsin.

29 **FISCAL IMPACT:** The fiscal impact is \$113,209 in revenue from the State of Wisconsin.
