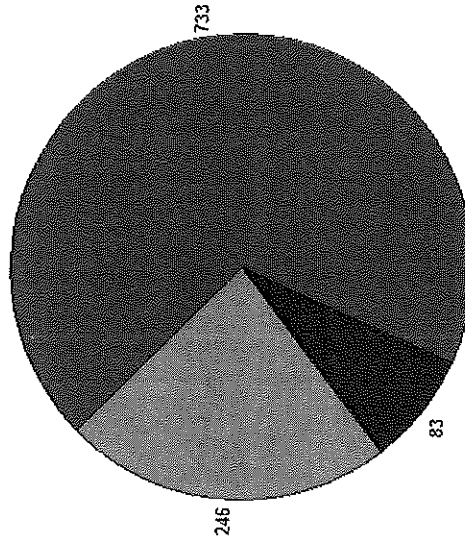

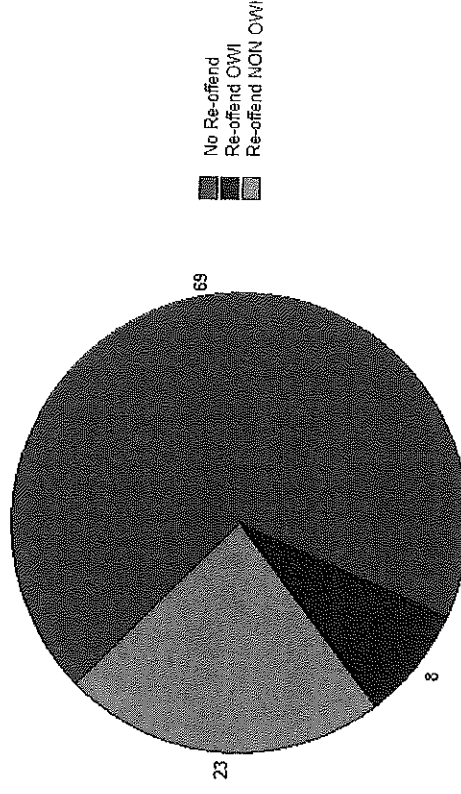

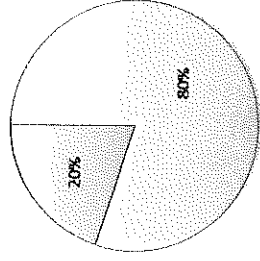

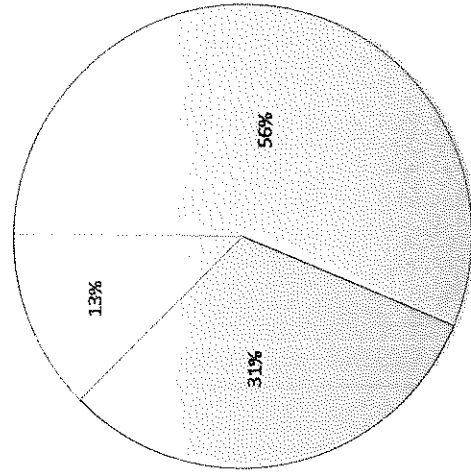

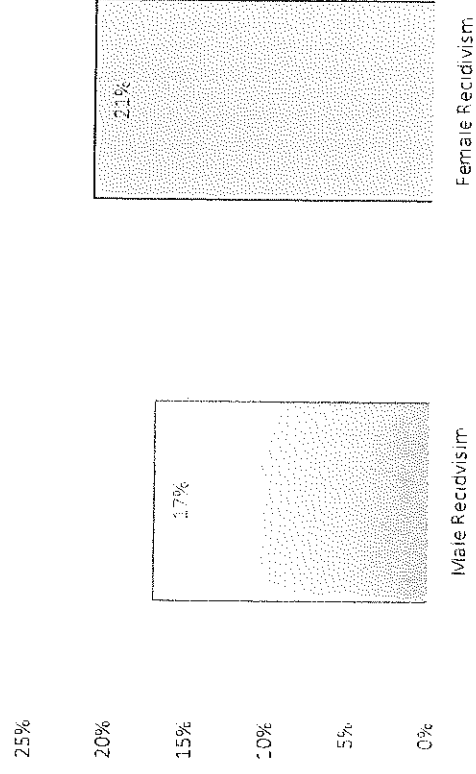


Recidivism Rates

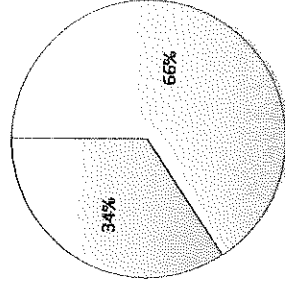

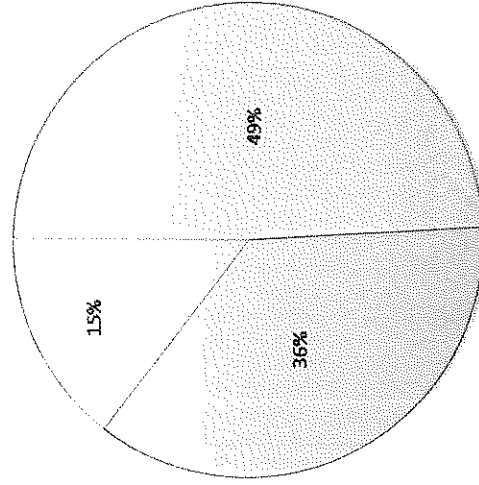

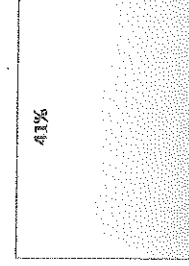

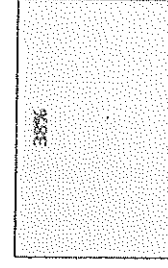


Male v. Female Recidivism Rate

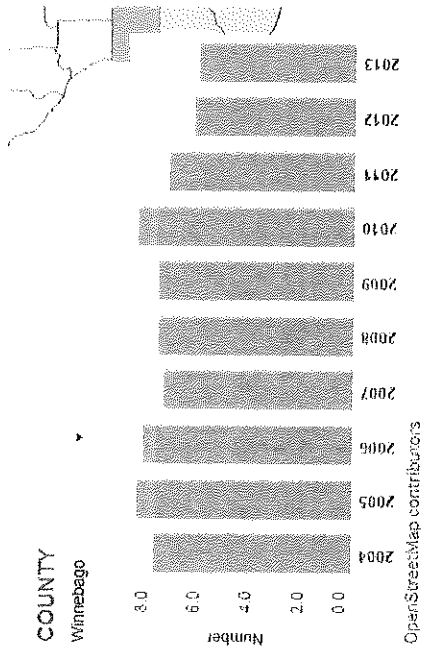

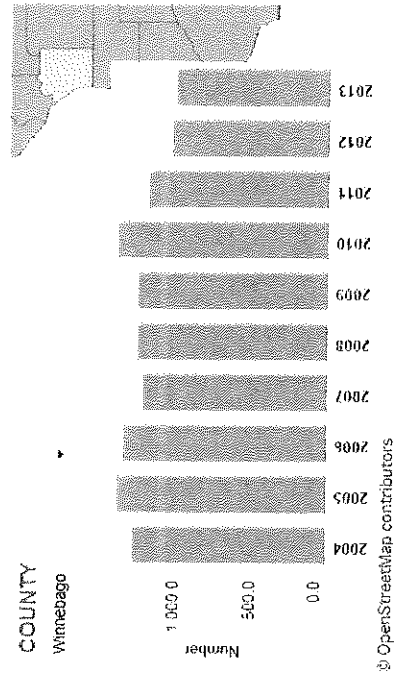


Female Recidivism

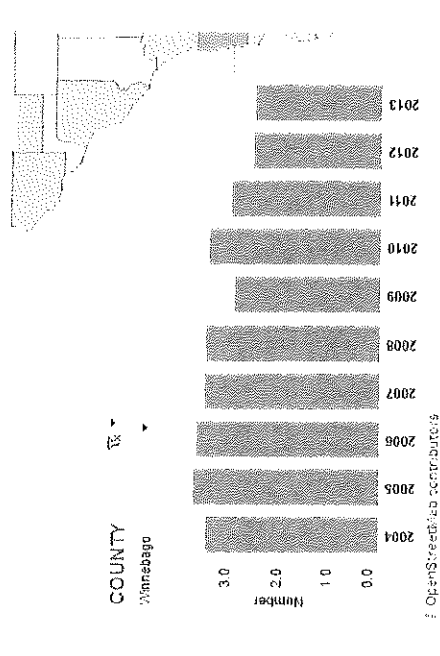
Total OWIs per 1,000 people 74.0 over 10 year span



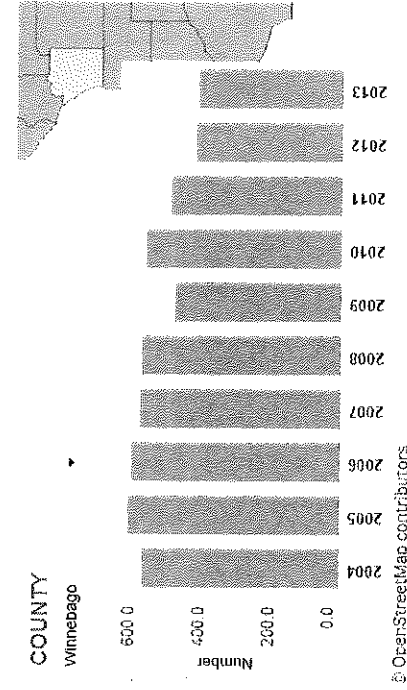
Total OWI 12,359 over 10 year span
