












Location type of overdose incident


Location type of death



In 2018, all overdose incidents occurred at a place of residence.




In 2018, most overdose deaths occurred in a place of residence; a were transported to a hospital.



# Incident Snapshot for Reviewed Deaths

### Narcan administration:

- 7 decedents received Narcan administered by EMS/fire department/law enforce
- All others were found dead on scene
- No decedents had Narcan/naloxone on site at time of death
- Majority of decedents were alone, unable to administer Narcan

0 8 Neenah, 6 Menasha, 6 Oshkosh, 2 Smaller Communities


## Toxicity Screens for Reviewed Deaths


- 16 deaths with opioids listed as main cause of death
- 8 decedents tested positive for Fentanyl
- 10 decedents tested positive for marijuana or alcohol
- 7 opioid was main cause of death
- 3 deaths with gabapentin listed as one of the substances lead death


- Family History of Substance Use
- Many decedents had witnessed significant substance use by other r in household when growing up.
- Some experienced loss of a loved one due to substance use.
- Early Initiation
- Many decedents had documented substance use at an early age (A
