Vice Chairman Bill Wingren called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

### 1. <u>Supreme Court Rule 70.39(b)</u>

Judge Gritton gives overview of the Supreme Court rule and the necessity to create a long-range plan for court facilities. Discussion as to the history of the "Courthouse Security Committee" and of prior planning. Judge Woldt continues the discussion of where do we go from here and what things look like in the future.

### 2. <u>Tour of the Courthouse</u>

 $5^{\text{th}}$  Floor IS Offices – Discussion of need for low traffic offices on upper levels of the building for security and logistic purposes; concerns with aging elevator system. Ideal for Corporation Counsel and Family Court Counseling offices.

 $\frac{4^{th} \text{ Floor Courtroom & Clerk of Court Offices}}{4^{th} \text{ Floor Courtroom, concern for jury}}$  box location to the witness stand. Need for jury room and witness rooms. Space concerns for the Clerk's office and the volume of files. To eliminate high traffic volume from the  $4^{th}$  floor, clerk should move to  $1^{st}$  floor and Branch 6 could be created here.  $3^{rd} \text{ Floor Jury Rooms} - \text{Only 2}$  rooms shared by 4 courts; need to create additional rooms like these in the courthouse. Discuss the traffic flow of jurors to the courtrooms that these rooms serve, staircase to branch 4.

 $2^{nd}$  Floor Branch 4 Courtroom – No change to  $2^{nd}$  floor proposed at this time.

<u> $1^{st}$  Floor</u> – Discussion of how to move Clerk of Court to  $1^{st}$  floor and bring the Court Commissioner, also high volume traffic court, from the Public Safety Building to the Courthouse.
