1 199-42013 Authorize \$480,000 for the Replacement of 54-Year-Old Boilers at UW Fox **RESOLUTION:** 2 Valley. 3 4 TO THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS: 5 6 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin—Fox Valley campus is an important asset to Winnebago County; 7 and 8 WHEREAS, the boilers in the original building were installed in 1959; and 9 WHEREAS, the boilers are very inefficient and now require ongoing and frequent maintenance; and 10 WHEREAS, it is prudent to replace the boilers before a major breakdown occurs; and WHEREAS, the project is funded 50% by Outagamie County and 50% by Winnebago County, making each 11 12 County's share \$240,000; and 13 WHEREAS, Outagamie County has already approved its share of the expense; and WHEREAS, the Winnebago County Facilities and Property Management Committee unanimously approved 14 15 the project. 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby 17 appropriates \$480,000 to a capital project to replace the boilers at the University of Wisconsin—Fox Valley and that funding of the project will be split between Outagamie County and Winnebago County, with each County's share 18 19 being \$240,000. 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that Winnebago County's 21 share of the project will be appropriated from the General Fund Undesignated Fund Balance. 22 Fiscal Note: Winnebago County's \$240,000 share will be transferred from the General Fund Undesignated Fund 23 Balance.
