RESOLUTION: Supporting a Bill Establishing a Pay Progression Plan for Assistant District Attorneys

WHEREAS, a proposed Bill has been circulated to establish a pay progression plan for Assistant District Attorneys; and

WHEREAS, said proposed Bill would create 17 hourly salary steps for Assistant District Attorneys; and

WHEREAS, said proposed Bill would allow Assistant District Attorneys who have been employed for more than twelve (12) months as of July 1, 2013, to be paid at an hourly rate as opposed to a salaried rate upon the approval of their supervising District Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Committee recommends support of said legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors that it hereby indicates their support for the proposed Bill establishing an hourly pay progression plan for Assistant District Attorneys.
