POSITION PURPOSE: FUNCTIONS AS A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IN A VARIETY OF COURT PROCEEDINGS INVOLVING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.

POSITION IN ORGANIZATION: REPORTS TO THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYAND THE DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

MAJOR DUTIES

- 1. Prosecutes felony, misdemeanor, juvenile and ordinance offenses.
- 2. Conducts research on pertinent decisions, laws, regulations, and other matters related to cases.
- 3. Reviews police incident reports and makes charging decisions. Dictates criminal complaints, as required by Wisconsin Statutes for formal prosecution.
- 4. Handles court calendars including initial appearances, further proceedings, motion hearings, and plea and sentencing hearings.
- 5. Acts as an "on-call" resource for local law enforcement agencies concerning preparation of warrants and subpoenas.
- 6. Prepares for and conducts preliminary examinations.
- 7. Prepares for and conducts jury trials and court trials.
- 8. Researches and prepares briefs for post-conviction motions and appeals.
- 9. Performs related duties as assigned.

PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTABILITIES

- 1. Ensures prosecution of all assigned cases involving Winnebago County is in the best interest of the citizens.
- 2. Ensures guidance is provided to both law enforcement agencies and citizens.
- 3. Ensures that Winnebago County is competently and professionally represented in court.
