The updated booster is available those 12 years and older.



- Get vaccinated. Staying up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines is the best thing you can do, no matter the community level.


#### **Current Community Level Metrics for Winnebago County:**


### 7 DAY CASE RATE FOR PCR CONFIRMED + PROBABLE CASES

### HOSPITALIZATIONS IN FOX VALLEY HERC REGION




### PERCENT POSITIVITY FOR WISCONSIN (PAST 7 DAYS) ♂
