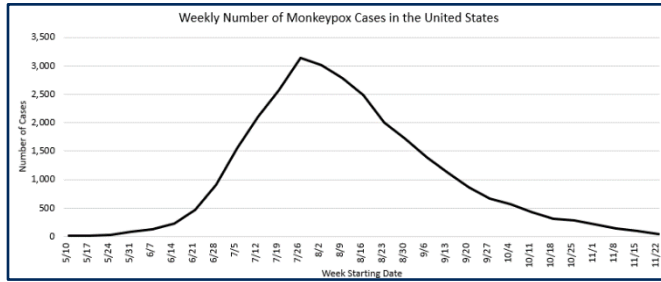

### Key Points:

- Monkeypox does not spread easily to others, and the risk of monkeypox spreading widely throughout our community remains low.
- Getting [vaccinated](#) ([information on who should receive vaccine](#)), asking your healthcare provider [to test you](#) if you have [a rash](#) consistent with monkeypox, and [isolating](#) if infected continue to be important tools in reducing spread of the virus.
- Winnebago County Health Department is currently offering the JYNNEOS monkeypox vaccine, by appointment only, to individuals at risk of infection based on the [Wisconsin Department of Health Services](#) prioritization.
