
- Community Level is **MEDIUM**.

  - Get tested if you are ill or suspect exposure.
    - Telehealth Services are now available! Anyone with a positive test can receive free treatment via video chat or phone. <u>Please visit the DHS website</u> for more information.
  - Vaccinate or get your booster if you are eligible.
  - o <u>If you are at high risk for severe illness, speak with your health care provider about precautions you can take.</u>
  - o Consider wearing a mask if you are in contact with someone who is high risk.

#### **Community Recommendations:**

- If you are at <u>high risk of getting very sick</u>, wear a <u>high-quality mask or respirator</u> (e.g., N95) when indoors in public.
- If you have household or social contact with someone at high risk for getting very sick, <u>consider testing</u> to detect infection before contact, and consider wearing a high-quality mask when indoors with them.
- <u>Get vaccinated</u>. Staying up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines is the best thing you can do, no matter the community level.


#### **Current Community Level Metrics for Winnebago County:**





Telehealth Appointments

<u>With various respiratory illnesses spreading</u>, it is important to protect yourself and others against <u>influenza</u>, <u>RSV</u>, and <u>COVID-19</u>. To help prevent the spread of these illnesses you can:
