# COVID-19 WEEKLY SNAPSHOT FOR WINNEBAGO COUNTY



#### Key Points:

- Community Level is <u>LOW</u>.
- <u>DHS supports</u> the <u>CDC's recommendation</u> that children over 6 months are eligible to receive the updated bivalent COVID-19 vaccine. WCHD currently is only offering the Pfizer vaccine (including the bivalent vaccine and booster) to those over the age of 6 months.
- General recommendations (click each statement for more information):
  - #KnowBeforeYouGo <u>Test before going to group events to help protect others.</u>
  - Get tested if you are ill or suspect exposure.
    - Telehealth Services are now available! Anyone with a positive test can receive free treatment via video chat or phone. <u>Please visit the DHS website</u> <u>for more information.</u>
  - Vaccinate or get your booster if you are eligible.
  - If you are at high risk for severe illness, speak with your health care provider about precautions you can take.
  - o Consider wearing a mask if you are in contact with someone who is high risk.



- <u>Get vaccinated</u>. Staying up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines is the best thing you can do, no matter the community level.


#### **Current Community Level Metrics for Winnebago County:**


### **7 DAY CASE RATE FOR PCR CONFIRMED + PROBABLE CASES** *☑*





### HOSPITALIZATIONS IN FOX VALLEY HERC REGION 12






# PERCENT POSITIVITY FOR WISCONSIN (PAST 7 DAYS) ♂
