HEPA Vacuum Program

- A HEPA (High Efficiency Particle Air) vacuum is an industrial vacuum cleaner fitted with one or more HEPA filters. They are used for cleaning up hazardous substances such as lead dust.
- Lead can be very fine, breaking down into tiny particles that pass right through the filter of an ordinary vacuum.
- Children can become lead poisoned by swallowing or breathing in lead dust.
- You can borrow a HEPA vacuum cleaner through the Winnebago County Health Department. There may be a minimal fee to cover the cost of the bag.
