SERVICES & PROGRAMS FOR OLDER ADULTS:

Wisconsin Well Woman Program (WWWP)

WWWP helps women 40 and older, with little or no health insurance, get free breast and cervical cancer screenings. Winnebago County Public Health coordinates the program for the following counties: Green Lake, Outagamie, Sheboygan, Fond du Lac, Marquette, Waupaca, Waushara, Calumet, and Winnebago. Women ages 35-39, with symptoms and concerns, may also be eligible.

Wellness Plus Classes

Our Wellness Plus classes are researched and tested to help participants self-manage their health. They also provide social connections and enhance the quality of life. In-Home Nurse Visits

Winnebago County Public Health nurses are available to come to your home and help manage chronic health conditions, identify ways to manage your medications, build confidence and independence, and provide additional resources.

In-Home Falls Prevention Assessment

Falls are common, but often preventable. Let our trained nurses conduct an in-home visit to assess the risk of falling in your house.
