Alene works with the employers to see what they are looking for with regards to employment. Tony and Richard work with the veterans themselves to get them into their career. They work with job services, Voc Rehab, Title one dislocated worker (adult and youth), and the WISE Program (55 and older retraining program).

As mentioned, Richard and Tony work with veterans to not just get a job, but to get career. They are striving to help veterans succeed, and will follow them until they are confident they are succeeding. Their goal is to help veterans transition into the civilian working world.

There are multiple ways of helping veterans via DWD. They will find ways to help veterans get retrained if this is the barrier.
