Why was the dashboard created?

This interactive tool was created to allow county board members and the public to see the location and progress of project requests across Winnebago County.

What type of devices can I use to view the Spirit Fund Dashboard?

The dashboard is designed for large-screen devices such as a tablet, laptop, or desktop computer. It is not intended for use on a smartphone.

What is the difference between County Government Project and Government Identified Project?

County Government Project - Projects requested by Winnebago County Departments

Government Identified Project – Projects requested by community partner agencies.

Where can I find more information about a specific project?

Each project "details window" has requesting agencies and County Board resolution numbers listed.

What is the difference between an "In Progress" and "Complete" project?

In Progress – The requesting agency or department has completed all necessary accountability documentation and funds have been delivered. The total funds delivered is shown in the upper left of the dashboard.

Complete – Winnebago County has received notice from the requesting agency or department that the project has been completed.

How do I reset the dashboard settings, so it looks like it did when I started?

To reset, click the circular reset button in the lower right corner.


