

# Marijuana Use and Winnebago County High School Students

## What is the problem?

- **31.1%** of students reported using marijuana at least one time.
- **7.1%** of students reported using marijuana for the first time before the age of 13.
- **19.4%** of students reported using marijuana during the past 30 days.
- **46.3%** of students reported that they strongly disapproved or disapproved of people smoking marijuana occasionally.
- **40.5%** of students reported that people their age would say it is not at all wrong or a little bit wrong to smoke marijuana occasionally.
- **26.2%** of students reported that they think people do not risk (no risk) harming themselves if they smoke marijuana occasionally.

## What are the solutions?

K-12 skill-based health education  
Evidence-based drug prevention programs  
Trained staff  
Parent and community education  
Coordination of school and community-based efforts  
Regular assessment of drug prevention efforts
