Physical Activity and Winnebago County High School Students

What are the issues?

- **48.0%** of students reported that they were physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes per day on 5 or more of the last 7 days.
- **22.0%** of students reported that on an average school day they watch 3 or more hours of TV.
- **31.9%** of students reported that on an average school day they play video or computer games or use a computer for something that is not school work for 3 or more hours.
- **54.1%** of students reported that on average they attended physical education classes on 2 or more days in a week.
