

Traffic Safety and Winnebago County High School Students

What are the issues?

- **7.9%** of students reported rarely or never wearing a seat belt when riding in a car driving by someone else.
- **16.1%** of students reported having rode in a car or other vehicle driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol one or more times during the past 30 days before the survey.
- **6.7%** of student reported having driven a car or other vehicle when they have been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days before the survey.
- **26.9%** of students report having text or e-mail while driving a car or other vehicle in the 30 days prior to this survey.

What are the solutions?

Driver education Evidence-based alcohol prevention programs
Social norms campaign
Parental monitoring and modeling
Primary enforcement seatbelt laws
Enforcement of drinking and driving laws
High visibility traffic enforcement initiatives
Consistent seat belt education
