COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC AT FOX CROSSING FIRE DEPARTMENT EVERY TUESDAY IN FEBRUARY

OSHKOSH, Wis. (January 31, 2022) – The Winnebago County Health Department will continue offering free COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Neenah at the Fox Crossing Fire Department (1326 Cold Spring Rd., Neenah, Wis.) each Tuesday in February. The clinics will be Tuesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

"COVID-19 cases are still very high. Vaccination continues to play an important role in slowing the spread and preventing hospitalizations and deaths," said Doug Gieryn, director/health officer for the Winnebago County Health Department. "This clinic increases vaccine access to our more rural residents.
