Appointments are NOT required. Vaccination is open to all individuals aged 18 and older. The clinic will be administering the Moderna vaccine, which is a 2-dose series vaccination. Participants will need to return for a second dose on May 19th. You will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following the second dose of your vaccination.

We hope offering an unscheduled, walk-in clinic will allow more people an opportunity to be vaccinated," stated Doug Gieryn, Winnebago County Health Department Director/Health Officer.
