# Continued Demand Prompts Extension of Walk-In Wednesday Vaccine Clinics at Sunnyview Expo Center

Free Vaccination Clinics Offered Each Wednesday in July, Except July 7

**OSHKOSH, WIS. (July 2, 2021)** – The Winnebago County Health Department will continue offering free walk-in COVID-19 vaccination clinics at Sunnyview Expo Center (500 E County Road Y, Oshkosh, Wis.) from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. each Wednesday for the remainder of July, with the exception of July 7.

"We continue to see people come to our clinics who either did not know they were eligible to receive a vaccine or who have been hesitant to get their vaccination," said Doug Gieryn, director/health officer for the Winnebago County Health Department. "Even if you just have questions for our public health nurses, we encourage you to visit our walk-in vaccination clinics, get your questions answered, and when you are ready, get your vaccination. If you are not able to walk in, just call our hotline and we can accommodate your needs."

All three vaccines will be available during each clinic, so people will have a choice between the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen, Moderna or Pfizer vaccine. **Appointments are NOT required.** Vaccination is open to all individuals aged 12 years and older.

Johnson & Johnson/Janssen is a one-dose vaccination. Moderna and Pfizer are both a two-dose vaccination series. Participants will be considered fully vaccinated 14 days following the completion of their vaccination series.

Pfizer is currently the only vaccine approved for individuals aged 12 years and older. Anyone under the age of 18 should plan to have a parent/guardian present.
